### The wards at the Stanmore site are:

#### Coxen Adolescent Unit



Coxen Adolescent Unit has 16 single ensuite rooms and four bays. Patients are admitted to the Unit because of their age rather than their condition.

#### Duke of Gloucester Ward



Duke of Gloucester is inside the Stanmore Building with 16 ensuite rooms and four bays, each with four beds.

## **Jubilee Rehabilitation Centre**



The Jubilee Rehabilitation Centre is a 22 bedded unit specialising in pain management programmes, hypermobility syndrome, chronic regional pain syndrome, shoulder and peripheral nerve rehabilitation
