Founded in 1963, the Friends' function was to provide extra care and comfort for the hospital's patients, visitors and staff. Major projects over the years included the funding of a Patients' Centre, a swimming pool and part funding of the Graham Hill Unit.

## Projects and funding

The main task of the Friends was to raise money for projects already decided upon in principle by the RNOH NHS Trust and to initiate others which were thought to be valuable. In all, the Friends have raised in excess of £2 million.
