
Spinal Cord Injury Centre



The London Spinal Cord Injury Centre (LSCIC) at the RNOH is one of only 11 in the UK designated to receive and treat spinal cord injured patients. The Centre currently has 40 beds for adults, children and young people.

SCI Medical Management



Spinal cord injury (SCI) is an insult to the spinal cord resulting in a change, either temporary or permanent, in the cord's normal motor, sensory, or autonomic function. The aetiology of SCI's are traumatic or non-traumatic.


Peripheral Nerve Injury Unit
